

THE MARGARET SHORT MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

The MARGARET SHORT Memorial Scholarship program is designed to recognize, encourage and support outstanding Black Hawk County students who have selected the field of Leisure Services for their careers. The criteria used for consideration will be based on the student's dedication, experience and commitment to the Leisure Services field, in its broadest sense.

Eligibility:

Residents of Black Hawk County (graduated from a Black Hawk County High School) who are full-time students (2nd year and beyond) enrolled in accredited institutions of higher education with a declared major in Leisure Services or related fields.

Application Process:

Applicant: Eligible students must complete the Margaret Short Memorial Scholarship application form and return it to Mark Gallagher, Sports Manager, Waterloo Leisure Services Commission, no later than April 2, 2010.

Note: Please include with all applications, a written letter of recommendation by a professional member of the Leisure Services Department of the applicant's school.

Please attach to this form a written synopsis, which should include, but not be limited to, the following:

- A. Your experience in recreational activities and/or work experience in the field.
- B. The determining factor in choosing recreation as your major.
- C. Specific areas within the broad field of "Leisure Services" which appeal to you the most and why.
- D. Your goals as a future professional in the Leisure Services field.
